

# Sterfly Multi-Day Packing List

**What's included:** Full camp services including tents, cots, chairs, meals, water, snacks, gear and flies if needed.

**Not included:** Fishing licenses, boaters passes, Tribal permit, Car shuttle (\$80 cash), waders and wading boots. Please feel free to bring beverages of your choice like beer, soft drinks, etc.

## List of items you'll want to bring:

- A small backpack with a change of clothes in it, in case you slip and take a swim.
- Sunscreen and sun hat
- Polarized sunglasses
- Raincoat
- Layers for variable desert weather (wool, fleece, synthetic materials - be prepared for a full day in the elements!)
- Waders and boots
- Sleeping bag (cot and pad provided)
- Camp clothes, toiletry bag, etc.
- Head lamp

## Rods:

- 8-9 ft. 4 or 5 weights for dry flies
- 9-10 ft. 5 or 6 weights for wet flies
- 3x and 4x 9 ft. leaders
- 3x, 4x, and 5x tippet

**As always we WILL supply fly's and rods and reels- If you don't have them DON'T worry about it!**

**Feel free to bring your own flies**, listed below are some good choices for the Deschutes, and if it's Salmon Fly Season don't hesitate to bring your favorite salmon fly patterns:

**Dry Flies** • Caddis size 14,16,18. (Tan, or olive). PMD size 16,18

**Wets or Nymphs** • Stonefly's size 6 & 8. (Black & gold). Caddis sparkle pupa size 14,16 (tan). Tungsten bead head Pheasant tails size 12,14,16. Tungsten bead head Prince size 14,16. Soft hackles size 14,16. (Brown or tan) Jig Nymphs. 10-14
